Response : Immediately call a POISON CENTER or doctor/physician. IF ON SKIN: Gently wash with plenty of soap and water. If eye irritation persists, get medical advice/attention. IF INHALED: Remove to fresh air and keep at rest in a position comfortable for breathing. If skin irritation occurs, seek medical advice/attention. IF IN EYES: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. In case of fire, use alcohol-type foam for extinction. IF SWALLOWED: Immediately call a POISON CENTER or doctor/physician. Get medical advice/attention if you feel unwell. If on skin or hair: remove/take off immediately all contaminated clothing. Rinse with water/shower. Specific treatment: refer to Label or MSDS. Remove/Take off immediately all contaminated clothing . Wash/Decontaminate removed clothing before reuse. Call a POISON CENTER or doctor/physician if you feel unwell.

Disposal : Allow to evaporate in safe open area (applicable for small quantities). The chemical should be burnt in a chemical incinerator equipped with burner and scrubber. If the volumes are larger than 500ml and no incinerator and site of evaporation is not available then transfer the waste chemical to waste solvent drum for collection by specialist disposal company.
