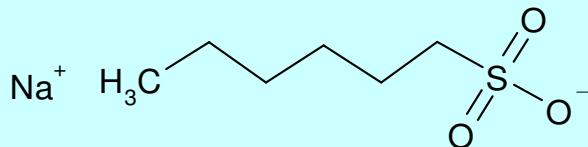

DANGER
